

ATTENTION ANGLERS

Due to the recent illegal introduction of rainbow smelt to Big Wadleigh Pond (T8 R15 WELS) and concerns about the native Arctic charr and brook trout populations found in the pond the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife has made changes to the fishing regulations.

The following fishing regulations are in effect for Big Wadleigh Pond:

- Open to Open Water Fishing – April 1 through September 30
- Closed to Ice Fishing (CI)
- S-1 (Closed to taking smelts)
- S-3 (Tributaries closed to taking smelts)
- S-6 (artificial lures only)
- S-7 (All trout, landlocked salmon, and togue caught must be released alive at once.)

The Big Wadleigh Pond regulations found on page 72 in the April 1, 2010-March 31, 2012 Fishing Law Book are superseded by the regulations above.
